PROGRAMMING

L. Conference

In Canada and abroad there are numerous examples of progress being made on issues such as climate change, clean energy, transportation decarbonization, and plastic pollution. Governments around the world are setting and supporting aggressive greenhouse gas reduction targets, electric vehicle adoption is growing at a rapid pace, and plastic pollution is starting to be meaningfully addressed.

Despite this progress, significant challenges remain. Additionally, we live in a period of disruption and rapid change. We need to be responsive to these changes to ensure sustained momentum. For example, at the onset of the global pandemic, transportation emissions initially plummeted due to lockdowns. However, subsequent trends, such as the avoidance of public transit and increases in car ownership in Canadian cities, began to erode those early environmental gains. Some authorities harnessed opportunities presented by the pandemic to lock-in positive outcomes such as the increased use of active transportation and teleworking. To appropriately respond in today's rapidly changing world we need to continually assess our environmental strategies and approaches to decision-making in the context of emerging challenges and opportunities.

The purpose of Pollution Probe's 2022 Conference and Gala is to explore how Canada can address emerging challenges and leverage opportunities for continued environmental gain. To kick things off, participants will hear from a panel of recognized experts in areas such as clean energy, transportation decarbonization, climate and ecology, circular economy, and society and politics. The focus of these brief presentations will be on how we can continue to make progress on environmental priorities despite disruptions such as the global pandemic, geopolitical instability, the polarization of social and environmental issues, and the growing prevalence of misinformation.




