PROGRAMMING:

I. Conference

Canada is making progress on issues such as climate change, clean energy, plastic pollution and the decarbonization of transportation systems. Governments across Canada are setting aggressive targets for greenhouse gas reductions and electric vehicle adoption, and supporting important plastic pollution prevention and cleanup initiatives.

While progress is being made, significant challenges remain, and there are concerns that current efforts may be insufficient to meet these targets. In addition, the policies and investments needed will require community support, consideration for reconciliation, and the equitable distribution of the costs and benefits.

The purpose of Pollution Probe's 2023 "Right Here, Right Now" conference, located at the Toronto Reference Library, is to explore how Canada can address the challenges we face and seize the opportunities presented by the transition to a cleaner economy.

To kick things off, participants will hear from a panel of speakers and changemakers contributing to efforts related to clean energy, transportation decarbonization, climate and ecology, circular economy, and society and politics. The focus of these brief presentations will be on how Canada can continue to ensure collective readiness for the transition to a clean economy, including in the areas of policy, investment, resources, and brainpower. A spotlight will be given to environmental readiness success stories from the community and businesses.

Following the panel discussion, breakout groups will explore ways to accelerate progress towards clean air, clean water and a healthy planet. Key findings and outcomes will be shared with participants and our broader network and will be used by Pollution Probe to inform near-term action and engagement. We look forward to having you join us!
